## **PRESIDENT WORD**

I am pleased to announce that Sylvie Bilodeau has accepted, on a volunteer basis, the position of Provincial Advocacy Officer for the Association. She will work with the National Office and coordinate with the six branches in Quebec to better defend the interests of NAFR members. Welcome aboard.

Although there was no election this year, Member Advocacy was very busy with our group insurance business. We experienced the transfer of the Public Service Health Care Plan (PSHCP) to Canada Life. It was an epic experience for some of us. The Government of Canada then announced that the contract to administer the Pensioners' Dental Services Plan (PDSP) had been awarded to the Canada Life Assurance Company (Canada Life). The transfer from Sun Life to Canada Life is expected to take place in November. As the saying goes: "Once bitten, twice shy".

Last December, the federal government launched a new program, the Canadian Dental Care Plan (CDCP), for eligible Canadian residents. Starting next May, the federal government will pay all or part of the cost of Sun Life dental insurance for eligible seniors. Only those who do not have access to dental insurance can apply for the CDCP.

Since we have access to the Pensioners' Dental Services Plan (PDSP), the vast majority of federal pensioners and their eligible family members, including survivors, are not eligible for the CDCP.

Many members would have liked to have been able to join the CDCP or, at the very least, for our current plan (PDSP) to have been improved. Unfortunately, to date, no such changes have been discussed with NAFR. I don't need to explain to you that this is not the fault of our office coordinator or Branch volunteers. Communicate with respect and be sensitive to the feelings of others. You know that empathy is a quality that improves with practice.

Register in large numbers for our next Annual General Meeting on April 12 in Quebec City, May 10 in Saguenay and May 22 in Matane. And we look forward to seeing you at our breakfast meetings and at l'Érablière du Cap on Tuesday, April 16. Have a good spring!

On January 26, I met with **Kristina Michaud**, **MP for Avignon**, **La Mitis**, **Matane**, **Matapédia**, along with Sonia Gagné, President of the Matane PSAC Branch, and two of her members, to discuss Canada Life issues. I represented the members of ANRF.

We shared with her the problems

encountered by our members. She was very receptive and took lots of notes.

A Bloc Québécois representative will be present at a national committee to discuss Canada Life.



PSAC Branch members Sébastien Ouellet and Kathleen Ross spoke about their issues and the serious unresolved problems.



I proposed that a help line be set up by experienced federal employees to assist our members. It's now easier to reach Canada Life, but for unresolved cases, the front-line person just passes on the message.

At present, it's our members and our association who help each other out, whereas in the federal public service it's the supervisors who lend a hand. There are serious confidentiality issues. Mrs Michaud found this suggestion interesting and will submit it.

We also discussed the Dental Plan, which will soon be transferred to Canada Life.
